

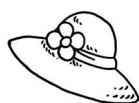
About the Arts & Crafts Building

This is the venue to show off your talents in gardening, quilting, needlework, as well as many other categories included in the competitive fields. There are also categories to show off your antique collectibles, toy collections, and other miscellaneous collectible categories. There are also several categories for Youth 16 and Under.

The competitive categories displayed in the building include: Vegetables, Floriculture, Arts & Textiles (Quilts and Other Sewing and Needlework), Fine Arts, Photography & Advanced Photography, Culinary and Hobbies, Antiques and Collectibles.

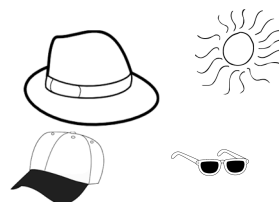

General Rules for Arts & Crafts Entries

All entries will be registered on **Tuesday, June 18, 2019**, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. No entries will be accepted after 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday.

- All departments are open to any age or gender.
- You do not need to be a resident of Montgomery County to exhibit.
- No more than two (2) entries per exhibitor in any class.
- The exhibit cannot have been shown previously at the Montgomery County Fair.
- All exhibits should be clean and ready for display.
- Judging will begin at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, June 19th. No one will be allowed in the building during judging except for judges, Department superintendents and their assistants.
- The building will remain closed until judging and displays are complete.
- Department superintendents reserve the right to reclassify incorrectly classified entries.
- The Fair Association reserves the right to remove decayed exhibits from display if necessary.
- **Exhibits will be released from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Sunday, June 23rd.**
- No article can be removed until the date and time stated in this booklet. If an article is removed, all ribbons and/or prize monies will be forfeited.
- Items not picked up by the stated time will become the property of the Montgomery County Fair.
